COVID-19 has introduced significant inconvenience and uncertainty into each of our daily lives - presenting us with new challenges every day. At FlyRight, we are working hard to promote a safe work and training environment for our staff and clients. Below are some of the practices and policies we are following to help guard your health and safety:

- We are thoroughly cleaning our facilities and training equipment to meet or exceed Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). This includes disinfecting wipes for our classrooms, procedure trainers, and simulators. We are providing increased sanitizer stations for staff and clients to disinfect their hands, and we encourage frequent, thorough hand-washing for everyone.
- Our customer service team is actively working with clients who may be concerned about traveling to their training. We will waive rescheduling fees at this time and work with you to get your training rescheduled.
- In order to mitigate risk of communicating COVID-19 within our facility, **the following procedures have been implemented for our employees in accordance with CDC and World Health Organization guidelines:**
 - We actively encourage employees to stay home if they are feeling sick or have any symptoms of illness
 - Follow good social distancing practices: As much as we enjoy shaking hands, we have shifted to other methods of greeting our valued friends and clients (elbow bumps are a good one!)
 - Encouraging video-conferencing and work-from-home for staff whose tasks do not require being in the office

- In order to mitigate the risk of transferring COVID-19 between staff and clients, **the following policies apply to both our clients and staff: The following individuals may not enter our Training Center:**
 - **Anyone who has a fever over 100.4 degrees, or who is taking fever reducing medication**
 - **Anyone who has been exposed to someone with COVID-19 or is traveling from an area with a high infection rate, will be required to either quarantine for 14 days or have a negative COVID-19 test completed with negative results within 72 hours of commencing training.**
